Reconfiguration of the Gyrotory and MC

This is the big issue and what we will be concentrating our efforts on.

Although great strides have been made over the last couple of years with Policy 21 and the Supplementary Planning Framework for MC as part of the New Local Plan 2030, there is still a long way to go.

We now need to **persuade** the City Deal, the Greater Cambridge Partnership and the new Mayoralty Office to allocate funds; firstly to commission an urban design study with public consultations etc. and then to develop a program of works with a time frame.
